

# Formal Wear Contract 2009-2010

- I. Your son/daughter has been given formal wear, a service provided by the High School Vocal Music Boosters for use this year. In order to assure that this service can continue into the future, some basic guidelines need to be established. Once you and your student have read and agreed to the following, the formal wear will be checked out to you for the year.
- II. Women - You are being given a garment bag with a formal gown and pearl necklace and ear rings.  
Men - You are being given a garment bag with a tuxedo jacket, tuxedo pants, a vest and tie.
- III. Please make sure that all materials are present and in good condition. If items are missing and/or damaged, it must be reported immediately to the Vocal Music Department. Your family will be responsible for replacement and/or repair costs for items that are returned damaged and/or missing.

**Replacement costs are as follows:**

- IV. Individual choir members must provide the following items on their own:

Women - You need black hose, and black, closed toe flats. No heels please and no buckles or other decorative "extras." *Pay Less Shoes* has this type of shoe for less than \$15.00. Basically, we are looking for plain and boring! You must take care of hemming your own dress (touch the top of your shoes). If needed, the vocal music department can assist you.

Men - You need to provide your own black socks and black dress shoes. Remember that this is formal wear. Black tennis shoes and/or boots are not acceptable. You must take care of hemming your own pants. If needed, the vocal music department can assist you.

Students who do not have the acceptable attire, that is neat and pressed, will not be allowed to perform. Students may change clothes in the dressing rooms at the school before and after events if they wish.

- V. At the conclusion of the school year, each student must return their formal wear. It must be dry cleaned and all items must be present, accompanied by your dry cleaning receipt. After the items are received, an inventory will be done and students with missing and/or damaged items will be billed accordingly. If damage occurs due to a dry cleaner's negligence, it needs to be worked out between you and the cleaner. You are ultimately responsible. This must all be taken care of before students will be allowed to check out at the end of the year.
